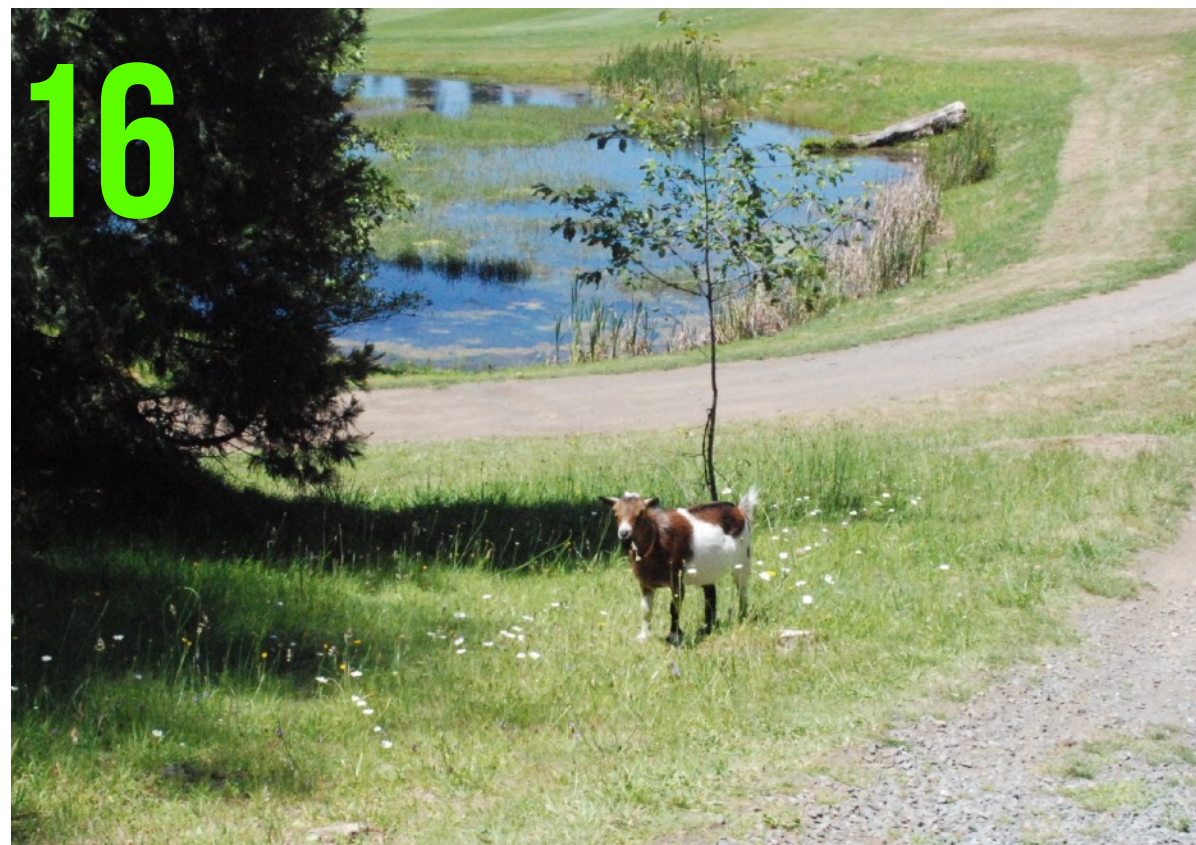

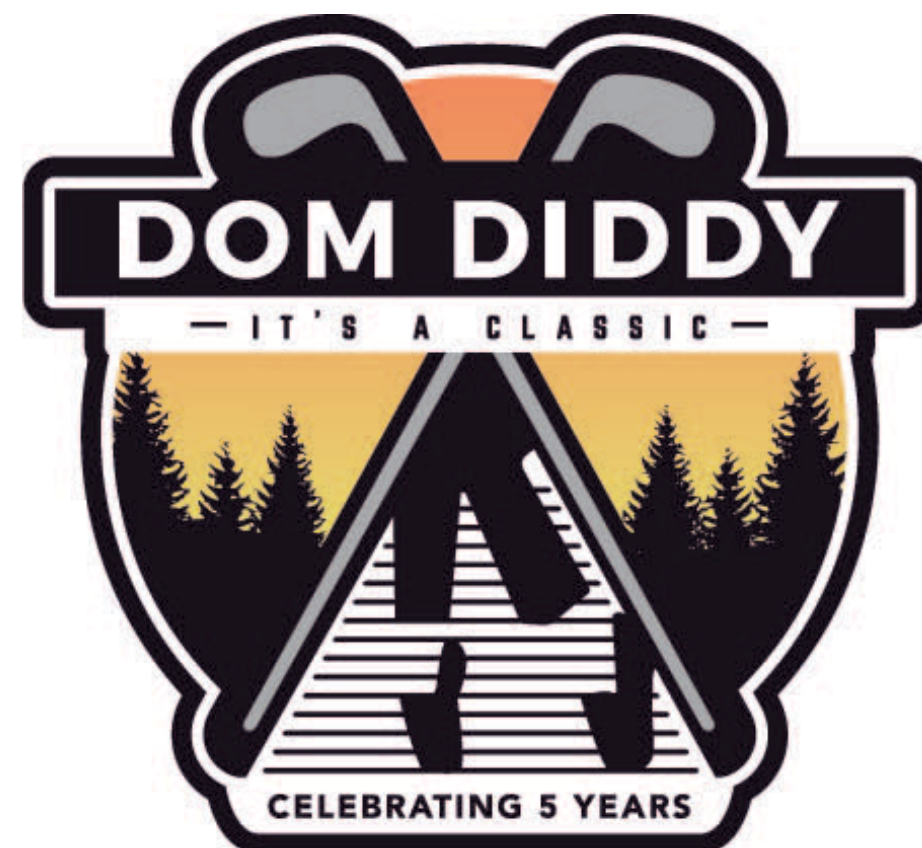

2022 DOM DIDDY CLASSIC

We received so much support in 2022, the Dominic Fouts Memorial Cancer Fund was able to give \$30,000 to OHSU Knight Cancer Institute, \$30,000 to Providence Cancer Institute, and \$30,000 to St. Charles Cancer Center.

This record \$90,000 went to these hospital foundations, OHSU Foundation, Providence Portland Medical Foundation, and St. Charles Foundation, where they are designated to each's cancer patient support services programs including charity care, social and nutritional services and integrated therapies. 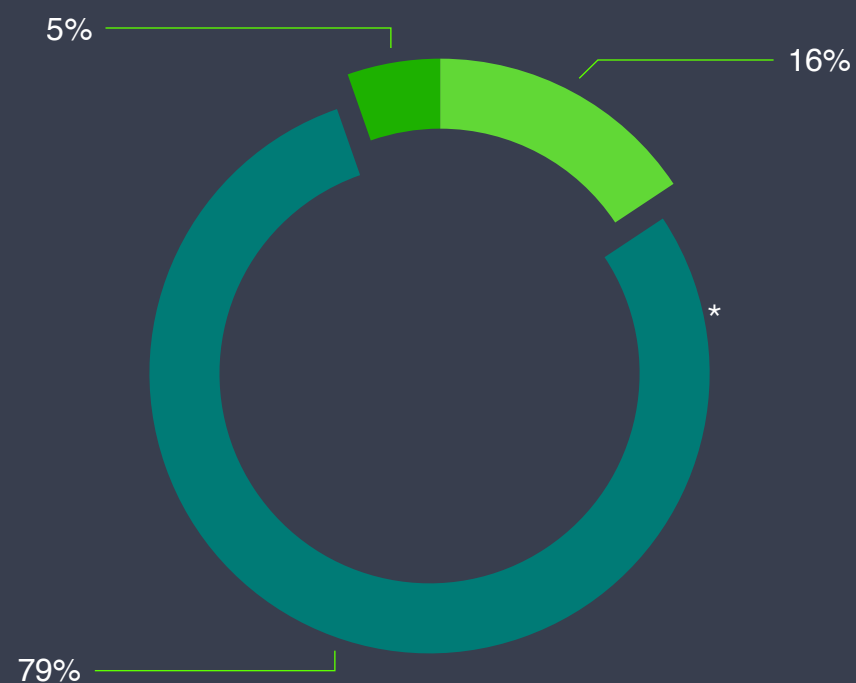
